

Resurrection - Ours too

Easter is not just the celebration of the victory of Christ. We are not just commemorating or remembering an event in the past, no matter how important that may be. It is the celebration of our victory over evil in and through Christ! Christ is no longer someone separate from us. By baptism, we partake in his life. His life is now ours.

St. Paul reminds us, 'are you unaware that we who were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death? We were indeed buried with him through baptism into death, so that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, we too might live in the newness of life' (Romans 6: 3-4).

We need this celebration because often in life we get the impression that evil is so strong and we are overwhelmed by it. We hear so many bad news that we are tempted to think that there is no way to get out of evil. And worse, there is even no effort to fight it and to keep away from it. But the good news is that evil can be overcome! The devil does not have the last say. Jesus has shown us the way and has given us the power. The power of the resurrection that has been effective in Jesus is also working in each one of us.

For a Christian, there is no such a thing as a hopeless case. What could be worse than the Israelites' experience of being cornered between the Egyptian army and the sea? What could be more hopeless than being in the tomb for three days? Yet, in both cases the power of God burst forth. The Israelites marched through the sea on dry ground while Jesus went out his tomb standing and with newness of life.

This is also the life of Christians. We don't just survive evil or misfortunes; we have a new life that takes away the sting of evil. Yes, we still sin, but we are assured that God will always accept us whenever we turn to him because he has adopted us as his children. We still suffer evil but this suffering can draw us closer to God and to each other. We still die, but death is no longer the end but the entrance into God's embrace. This is our new reality as sharers in God's love. All of this comes because of the resurrection of Jesus, the Christ.
