First Reconciliation & First Communion Registration

For Grade 2 students receiving the Sacraments of First Reconciliation and First Communion in 2019, **the parent information session and registration** will be held **on** <u>Saturday, September 15th at 10:30 a.m.</u> in the church. Parents are required to attend this meeting at which time you will receive information about the preparation process for the Sacraments.

Confirmation & Preparation Programme

For Grade 7 students receiving the Sacraments of Confirmation in 2019, **the parent information session and registration** will be held on <u>Saturday, September</u> <u>29th at 10:30 a.m</u>. in the church. Parents are required to attend this meeting when you will receive information about the preparation process for the Sacraments.

Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults (RCIA)

The RCIA is a process by which an adult (18 years of age or older) becomes a full member of the Catholic Church. The Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist) are received at Easter Vigil, the Saturday evening Mass before Easter Sunday.

RCIA is for the following individuals:

- An unbaptized person who wants to be baptized into the Catholic Church.
- A member of another Christian denomination who wants to become a Catholic.
- A baptized Catholic who wants to be fully initiated through the Eucharist and Confirmation.

Expectations:

- Attend Sunday Mass faithfully, every week.
- Attend evening classes Tuesday at 7:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. Classes start in October and end around Easter.
- Choose a sponsor, a fully initiated, practicing Catholic.
- Welcome people into a warm encouraging circle, celebrating our diversity and seeking faith enrichment.
