Five (5) Types of Prayer Part 2 of 2

"Prayer," St. John Damascene wrote, "is the raising of one's mind and heart to God or the requesting of good things from God." At an even more basic level, a <u>prayer is a form of communication</u>, a way of talking to God or to the saints, just as we talk to family or friends.

As the Catechism of the Catholic Church notes, however, not all prayers are the same. The Catechism describes *five basic types of prayer*. Here are brief descriptions of each type of prayer, with examples of each.

- 1. Blessing and Adoration (Worship)*
- 2. Petition*

3. Intercession

Prayers of intercession are another form of prayers of petition, but they are important enough to be considered their own type of prayer. As the Catechism of the Catholic Church notes, "Intercession is a prayer of petition which leads us to pray as Jesus did." In a prayer of intercession, we're not concerned with our needs but with the needs of others. Just as we ask the saints to intercede for us, we, in turn, intercede through our prayers for our fellow Christians, asking God to shower His mercy on them by answering their requests. A Prayer of Parents for Their Children and these Weekly Prayers for the Faithful Departed are good examples of prayers of intercession for the needs of others.

4. Thanksgiving

Perhaps the most neglected type of prayer is a prayer of thanksgiving. While <u>Grace Before Meals</u> is a good example of a prayer of thanksgiving, we should get into the habit of thanking God throughout the day for the good things that happen to us and others. Adding the Grace After Meals to our regular prayers is an excellent way to start.

5. Praise

Prayers of praise acknowledge God for what He is. As the Catechism of the Catholic Church notes, praise "lauds God for his own sake and gives him glory, quite beyond what he does, but simply because HE IS. It shares in the blessed happiness of the pure of heart who love God in faith before seeing him in glory." The *Psalms* are perhaps the best-known example of prayers of praise. Prayers of love or charity are another form of prayers of praise—expressions of our love for God, the source and object of all love. The *Act of Charity, a common morning prayer*, is good example of a prayer of praise.
