The Spiritual Symbolism of Jesus' Appearances on Easter Sunday Part 1 of 2



Jesus appeared multiple times on the day of his resurrection, and spiritual writers have reflected on the symbolism of each over the centuries.

When reading the Gospel accounts of Jesus' resurrection, it's sometimes easy to miss the fact that Jesus appeared multiple times to various people on the day of his resurrection. According to the Golden Legend, a medieval text that compiled various traditions that the Catholic Church has handed down over the centuries, Jesus appeared five times on Easter Sunday, and each appearance has a secondary spiritual meaning.

First Appearance



Jesus' first appearance was to Mary Magdalene shortly after dawn, "Now when he rose early on the first day of the week, he appeared first to Mary Magdalene, from whom he had cast out seven demons." (Mark 16:9)

The Golden Legend explains how, "Here Mary represents all repentant

sinners... [and he appeared to her] in order to show that he had died for sinners." Furthermore, just, "as a woman had been the messenger of death, so a woman should be the one to announce life."

Second Appearance



Then Jesus appeared to the other women who were coming back to the tomb. These "women here stand for the humble," for when they saw him "they came up and took hold of his feet and worshiped him" (Matthew 28:9).
