## A Prayer for when the **Host and Chalice** are elevated at Mass

Renew in your soul a sense of awe and wonder at what happens at the consecration.



The Catholic Church firmly believes that after the words of consecration said by a priest at Mass, by the power of the Holy Spirit, bread and wine are transformed into the body, blood, soul and divinity of Jesus Christ. It is a great mystery, one that has been handed down to us from Jesus Christ at the Last Supper.

In the Roman Rite of the Catholic Church, it is customary during the Eucharistic prayer to elevate the consecrated Host as well as the chalice holding the precious Blood, lifting them up for the people to see.

While this action of the priest is often brief, the faithful are **encouraged to make a silent act of love to God.** Many spiritual writers suggest using the words of St. Thomas the Apostle when he encountered the Risen Christ, as the priest elevates the Host... "My Lord and my God" (John 20:28)

It is traditional to pray silently, when the Chalice is elevated... "My Jesus, mercy!"

It is a way to express your own belief that God is truly there, overcoming any doubts you may have, similar to what St. Thomas experienced.

Whatever you do during the consecration at Mass, look up and see the Risen Lord and offer to Him your love and adoration. He comes during Mass for you and desires to dwell in your heart.
