From the ShareLife Office



Our 2019 campaign is now complete, and our parishes raised \$13.015 million toward the work of ShareLife and Catholic Charities-funded agencies. We are grateful for the continued support of our clergy and parishioners.

Overall the ShareLife campaign achieved **\$14.872 million**, which is a decreased from the previous final result of \$15.234 million.

We would especially like to thank the 101 parishes that achieved an increased campaign result this year, as well as the 64 parishes that exceeded the 2019 campaign goal suggested from our office.

We are also grateful for the support of our school communities toward ShareLife. This year, the schools campaign increased from \$568,000 to **\$593,000**.

Holy Cross Parish raised a total of \$24,506.35.

Once again, we have experienced the generosity of our clergy and parishioners from across our archdiocese.
