

Easter is the greatest and the most important feast of the Christian faith. If Jesus did not rise from the dead, what is the use of coming to Church, of seeking for the Kingdom of God?

easter then invites us to go beyond greeting each other "HAPPY EASTER", or getting together for meals to celebrate Easter, but this feast invites us to continue the mission of Jesus Christ – His mission of bringing salvation to more people in our world today. How can we do this? Be like the Risen Jesus. Look at the Risen Jesus. Love the Risen Jesus. Follow the Risen Jesus.

Why should we be like Jesus? Why look, love and follow Jesus? What is it in Jesus that we must carry with us and be able to bring to others? It is His JOY! We yearn for joy. We work for joy. Yet, with what is happening in our world today because of this pandemic, we often fail to find JOY.
