Sunday Gospel Reflection

4th Sunday of Ordinary Time

Gospel: Matthew 5:1–12a

When Jesus sees the crowds, He goes up the mountain and sits down. This simple gesture matters. Sitting was the posture of a teacher, and the mountain evokes Mount Sinai, where God once gave Moses the Law. But Jesus does not repeat the old law; instead, He reveals a new way of living — the way of the Kingdom of Heaven.

The Beatitudes turn our understanding of success upside down. Jesus calls "blessed" those whom the world often overlooks: the poor in spirit, the meek, the mourners, the merciful, the peacemakers, and those who suffer for righteousness. In doing so, He challenges us to examine what we value and where we place our trust.

To be **poor in spirit** is not simply to lack material wealth. It means recognizing our deep dependence on God — acknowledging that we cannot save ourselves. When we let go of the illusion of self-sufficiency, we make space for God's grace to work in our lives. This humility opens the door to the Kingdom. Jesus also blesses those who **mourn** and those who are **meek**. Mourning here is not only personal grief but sorrow over sin, injustice, and suffering in the world. Meekness is not weakness; rather, it is strength under control, choosing gentleness over domination. These qualities allow God's healing and justice to take root.

The Beatitudes call us to an interior transformation. Hungering and thirsting for righteousness means longing for God's will more than personal comfort. Being pure of heart requires integrity, sincerity, and a single-hearted love for God. Peacemakers do not merely avoid conflict; they actively work to build reconciliation and bridge divisions, even when it is costly.

Jesus does not hide the cost of discipleship. He warns that those who live by these values may be ridiculed, opposed, or persecuted. Yet He ends with a surprising command: "**Rejoice and be glad.**" Why? Because faithfulness to God always leads to life, even when it involves suffering. Our reward is not rooted in worldly approval but in communion with God.
