

Incident of Vandalism at Our Church

It is with sadness that we share news of another incident of vandalism on our church property. In the early morning of January 30, 2026, while our custodian, Rico, was completing his routine rounds in the church hall, he discovered damage in the men's washroom located in the basement. Upon opening the door, a squirrel jumped out, and further inspection revealed that a window had been broken, allowing the animal to enter.



We are grateful to Rico for his attentiveness and quick response. He placed a temporary cover over the broken window using a piece of plywood. We will continue to take steps to ensure the safety and security of our parish facilities.

We have reported the incident to the police, and an incident number has been issued for further investigation.

Our church has been vandalized three times within a span of two months: December 8 and 25, 2025, and most recently on January 30, 2026. We ask for your continued prayers for the protection of our church community.
