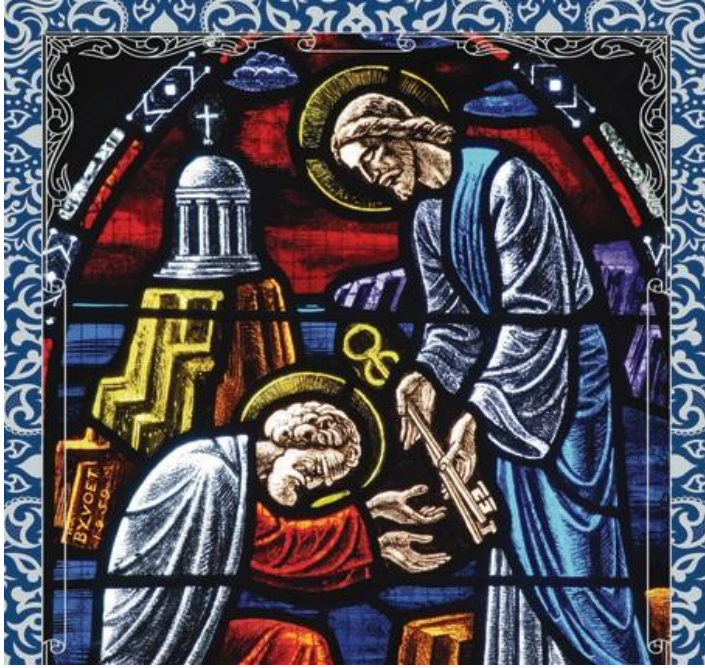


"THE ROCK BENEATH OUR FEET"

Message from the Pastor



This Sunday, Jesus asks His disciples, "Who do you say that I am?" Peter answers with clarity, and Jesus entrusts him with the keys — not because Peter is perfect, but because Peter is willing. Isaiah speaks of a key placed on the shoulder of Eliakim, a sign of responsibility and trust. St. Paul bursts into praise, declaring the depth of God's wisdom. My dear parish community, in a season of

transition, we are invited to remember the foundation beneath our feet. The Church is not built on personalities, preferences, or perfect plans — it is built on Christ, the Rock who steadies us.

Like Peter, we may feel unsure at times, yet God still entrusts us with the work of the Gospel. Like Eliakim, we carry responsibilities that call for humility and courage. And like Paul, we can pause and marvel at the wisdom of God guiding our parish. Let us root ourselves in Christ as we walk forward. The waves may rise, but the foundation does not move.
